# Morrissey Cops Chinook Winds

Tim Morrissey, pegging out of Centralia, WA, nailed down a huge win at the recent Chinook Winds Open in Lincoln City, OR. In besting the large field (184 players), Morrissey picked up 196MRP's, \$1,250, a trophy board, and bragging rights in winding down the year 2000 with a win.

Master Sharon Hejtmanek (MT) posted an excellent 763 MRP's in last year's action, but she has come out of the blocks with added determination this cribbage year...and took home 2nd. She has earned some 500MRP's this year in the early going. Jason Hofbauer (WA) took home 3rd, followed by rookie Jim Greenawald (OR) in 4th. This was Greenawald's first sanctioned tournament, and the 105 MRP's has him off and winging in ACC play.

Harold Schmeizer (OR) very nearly set an all-time record score in the qualifying round. He won 20 of 22, losing games 2 and 18 by 5 and 4 points. He posted the year's best score: 43 20/22 (85 MRP's)

Larry Hassett (OR) is zeroing in on his Grand Master by winning the 117-player Consolation. Master Lucille Endicott (OR) finished 2nd, followed by Grand Master Harvey Honeycutt (OR) and Master Roger Lueschow (WA) in 3-4. Jim Jackson (OR) topped the field in the qualifying round.



## Steinmetz Cops Jesse James

Life Master Wayne Steinmetz, Milwaukee, WI, once again, has tossed his hat in the annual race for honors by winning the 104-player Jesse James Open (Northfield, MN, Nov. 19). Steinmetz earned 147 MRP's for the win, adding to his lofty lifetime total of 7,500+.

Master Dave Gustafson (MN) nailed down 2nd, and brought home 105 MRP's. Master Bob Chase (MN) and Pat Upton (MN) came home 3-4. Chase was also the meet's top qualifier, scoring an extra nice 39 19/22 +245. His aggregate MRP take? 135 MRP's!

Director Jerry Gruber reported some 54 players played the Consolation, and it was Steve Post (MN) taking the top spot. Arnie Groskreutz (MN) finished 2nd, followed by Scott Nordlund (MN) and Lyle Lund (MN) in 3-4. LeLand Johnson (MN) won 7 of 9 to take qualifying honors.

A highlight of the meet saw Kevin Post, Minnetonka, MN, score the ACC's 5th 29-hand of the 2001 season. This 216,580 to 1 long shot netted Post \$100 from the ACC for this sanctioned 29-hand.

## Owens Tops River City

Local Tom Owens came home the winner at the recent River City Open in Orangevale, CA (suburb of Sacramento). His championship match with three-star DeLynn Colvert (MT) went to the wire, taking a weird hand on fourth street to secure the win. With both players about 20 points from winning in the deciding game, Colvert (dealing) held a J-Q-Q-Q, and a queen was cut, appearing to cut the winning card. But Owens held 5-10-J-K, led the king, and pegged six, scored 12 and needed but 2 pegs to win on the next deal. He scored the two pegs and won the match. The 4th queen decided the match. Owens brought home 147 MRP's, a four-figure winner's purse, a Roy Boyle's trophy board...and bragging rights.

Master Bob Clark (CA) and Adrian Levy (CA) finished 3-4 in this 117-player meet. Grand Master Roy Banducci (CA) scored a nice 35 GP card to take qualifying honors.

48 players played the Consolation and Master Phyllis Roderick (CA) very nearly ran the table, qualifying first (15 GP's) and finishing 2nd in the playoffs. But it was John Phren winning the playoffs, with Grand Master Frank Ornie (OR) and the streaking Grand Master Ron Morgan (CA) in 3-4. Ornie's high finish, once again, filled up his huge motor home's gas tank.

Director Steve Reynolds is a Life Master and he annually runs his Christmas Wrap event in December. This time around, he wrapped the winning purse and trophy boards...and took them home himself. In topping the 68-player field, Reynolds adds yet another 147 MRP's to his lofty lifetime totals (7,000+). Grand Master Roger King (CA) nailed down 2nd (and 105 MRP's), followed by Life Master Jones Hom (CA) and Rich Wardenburg (CA) in 3-4. Cres Fernandez (CA) scored an excellent 34 GP's (18 games) to easily take qualifying honors.

Tad Pilecki (CA) won the 38-player Consolation, with Grand Master Bill Wakeman (CA) taking home 2nd. Jim Crawford (CA) and One-Star Jesse Jarrell (CA) finished 3-4.

Jim Taylor (OR) and Master John Furler (OR) finished 3-4. Master Susan Chambers (OR) scored a nifty 35 16/22 +205 to take qualifying honors.

The streaking Grand Master Jim Hornbacher (WA), the nation's MRP leader, added a few more points to his ledger by copping the 34-player Consolation. Tony Murawski (WA) finished 2nd (and was top qualifier: 18 8/9 +136). Life Master George "Ras" Rasmussen (WA) and Anita Ertle (OR) finished 3-4.

Dave Kee (BC) topped the field in the Consolation qualifying round, winning 7 of 9, and he also finished 4th in the playoffs. Audrey Hatta (AB) won the playoffs (30 MRP's), followed by Brent Miners (BC) and Dennis Misenaar (AB). Misenaar also scored the ACC's 5th 29-hand of the year in this Consolation event...and will receive \$100 from the ACC for this gem. Doris Sanders had a hot weekend, scoring a 29-hand in the Early Bird, and a 28-hand in the Consolation. Ira Deutch, Oxnard, CA, entered Ed Bloom's Teeny Tiny event, knowing full-well that prize money was non-existent...but he needed 14 MRP's to earn his Master rating. And he earned his Master's in style! He won the event, taking home 147 MRP's to easily wing it to his Master rating.

Grand Master Jim Langley (CA) is in the thick of the MRP race this cribbage year, and he zipped to the 600 mark by taking home 2nd (he is among the top four peggers, nationally, this cribbage year). Life Master Jones Hom (CA) finished 3rd (once again) and is also scoring well this cribbage year. Grand Master Mary K. Ryan (CA) took 4th. Roy Kaufmann (CA) scored a nice 21 GP card (11 games) to take qualifying honors.

Bloom has an unusual sign-up format...players enter the Consolation as part of the entry fee...and a whopping 64-players were in action as a result (of the 76 who also entered the Main Event). R. M. Robson (CA) is nearing his Grand Master by winning this event. Del Robinson (CA) finished 2nd, with Master Wes Summers (CA) and Ann Sheeran (CA) in 3-4. Jeanne Jelke (CA) had a great 15 GP card in the 7-game qualifying round to easily take honors.

## ACC Suspension Policy

Recently, the Eastern Region has had a problem with a member wishing to play in a sanctioned event while under suspension by the Ethics Committee of the ACC. In a nutshell, this is the procedures the ACC Constitution and ByLaws treat suspensions:

1. An individual is charged by member(s) of ethics violations. These charges are forwarded to the ACC's Ethics Committee.
2. Ethics Committee investigates charges, giving accused 30 days to respond.
3. Ethics Committee, after 30-day period, makes decisions as to what actions to take.
4. Accused notified of actions by Ethics Committee, and is given 30 days to file for a hearing before the full Board of Directors.
5. The BOD and accused conduct closed-door hearing, and decide case by majority vote. If accused fails to apply for a hearing, BOD votes on disposition of case.
6. Until a suspension is lifted, a suspended player is not allowed to play in sanctioned events.

The American Cribbage Congress has this policy to protect our players from cheaters, members displaying conduct detrimental to the ACC, and others who would take advantage of their positions of authority, vested to them by actions of the Board of Directors. Actions against individuals are, of course, repugnant, but necessary to keep our game honest and on a high level of integrity.

# TIP

## The J-Q For Last

When holding four face cards (or three face cards) always try to hold a jack-queen for your last two. This will give you an extra four cards to score on in the pegging sequence.

Example: You are holding a 10-J-Q-K. Your opponent leads a 4. Play the king. Your opponent plays a A for 15-2. Which card to play? The 10! Holding the J-Q for last will give you an extra 4 cards to score a run on the next sequence. You cover all face cards (and 10) on the next lead. Only two queens (or two jacks) can burn you!

Your lead: Play the King, then the 10, (or vice-versa if a 10 or K is cut, leading to match the cut card) holding the J-Q for last. Your pegging will improve!


