Driving Directions:

From Clinton ferry dock head north on Hwy. 20 for 34 miles.Turn right on Sidney St. Club house is .2 miles on right. Must leave the Mukilteo dock no later than 8:00AM sailing to arrive on time.

Tournament registration and tournament set-up will start at 9:00 AM. Seating will be assigned by random card drawing. Play will start promptly at 9:30 AM or as soon as everyone is seated and instructions/announcements are completed. Tournament play of 18 games will be governed by ACC rules. Participants are expected to complete a game in about 15 to 20 minutes maximum. If a player typically takes 5 minutes longer to play a game than other participants, lunch will delayed by about 45 minutes for everyone and the tournament will complete about an hour and a half behind schedule. Also an odd number of players will create a need to play ten games before lunch break so that those that who have had a sit out will have completed nine games.
