- ★ Text the following information:

 - which mains you are playing
- ★ Walk-ins are permitted but preregistration is much appreciated so we can order meals.
- ★ \$5 per player in both mains will be donated to Johnson Cancer Center Muskegon in memory of Mark Van Dyke.
- ★ Players must be present 30 minutes before announced start times for registration, orientation, and random-draw seat assignments.
- ★ All tournaments pay 1-in-4 entrants (25%).

- ★ No Q-pools.
- ★ No muggins.
- ★ Side pools have 100% graduated payback to top 1-in-8 entrants.
- ★ Main entry fees include Friday supper and Saturday lunch.
